Dear Neighbours,

Our government recently introduced **Budget 2023**. Since then, I've been meeting with industry and labour leaders, local families and students, academics and advocates and my fellow elected representatives and I'd like to highlight parts of this new budget that will directly help Milton and Miltonians throughout 2023 and beyond.

Budget 2023 invests in Canadians as we continue to make a remarkable recovery from the COVID recession. We have a lot to be proud of, and every reason to be optimistic. Canada can claim the strongest economic growth in the G7 over the last year. Record-low unemployment. A record **86% labour force participation** rate for Canadian women, supported by our Canada-wide system of affordable childcare. Inflation has fallen for nine months straight, and the Bank of Canada predicts that it will fall to just **2.6%** by the end of the year.

Despite the good news, times are tough financially – mostly due to rising costs and mortgage interest rates. So as inflation abates, Budget 2023 invests in three main ways; targeted inflation relief for the Canadians who need it most, stronger **public health care**, including dental care for millions of Canadians, and significant investments to build Canada's **clean economy**, create good **middle class careers**, and foster a new era of economic prosperity for Canadians.

Canadians are fortunate. Collectively, we not only live in the greatest country in the world - we are also actively building it up. Canadians can do big things, and I have never been more optimistic about the future of our country than I am today.

AFFORDABILITY

Budget 2023 is primarily focused on affordability for Canadians. We've introduced the **Grocery Rebate** which will **help 11 million Canadians**; eligible couples with two children will receive up to **\$467**, single Canadians without kids will receive **\$234**, and seniors will receive up to **\$225** delivered through the GST rebate mechanism.

For students, we've eliminated interest on Canada Student and Apprentice Loans, forever, we're increasing Canada **Student Grants by 40%**, providing up to **\$4,200** for fulltime students and we are raising the limit from **\$210** to **\$300** per week of study.

Too many Canadians don't receive their benefits because they can't or don't file their taxes – we are tripling the number of Canadians eligible for automatic tax filing.

And more to help all Canadians:

- Launching the new Tax-Free First Home Savings Account and the housing accelerator fund
- Reducing credit card transaction fees for small businesses
- Increasing Canada Child Benefit.

HEALTHCARE

Healthcare is absolutely essential, and Canadians are proud of our system but it hasn't been meeting expectations. Budget 2023 introduces a **\$198.6 billion investment** into our healthcare systems in every province and territory to get Canadians the care they need and deserve. Here are the highlights:

and electrification industry forward

Milton is the fulcrum of Canada's Innovation Corridor – and Budget 2023 is putting an emphasis on clean and green energy technology; from electrification to renewables and the EV battery sector, creating more local jobs right here in the Town of Milton. Budget 2023 is bolstering Clean Technology and Green Electricity Investment Tax Credits to decarbonize and focus on a more sustainable feature for all Canadians, while investing in tomorrow's technology, growing a clean economy and investing in Canadian workers to fight climate change and build the net-zero industries of tomorrow. I recently visited two local leaders in the industry of electrification – Eaton Canada and Phoenix Contact, and they expressed a lot of support for these measures.



Budget 2023 also recognizes the importance of the skilled trades, applied research, innovation and work-integrated learning, so we are doubling the **Tradesperson Tool Deduction to \$1000** and continuing to support Student Work Placement Programs.

Additionally, the Labour Mobility Tax Deduction for Tradespeople provides tax recognition for up to **\$4,000 per year** in travel and temporary accommodation expenses to eligible tradespersons and apprentices who travel to work.


