

A MESSAGE ON AFFORDABILITY

As a follow-up to the **2023 Accountability Report** that started hitting doorsteps recently, I'm writing today for your insight. Throughout the summer, in my meetings with you and our community — I heard you loud and clear, the number one concern out there today is **Affordability**. This community mailer contains an update on our measures, but also an opportunity for you to send me your ideas with the **enclosed clip back** — no postage necessary. It can be anonymous, but I'd like to reply to as many as I can so include your details if you would like to continue the conversation.

Our most recent announcements include measures to increase the availability of rental housing, which will create better opportunities for families, young people, students and seniors alike. On the first day of Parliament in September, we summoned the CEOs of Canada's largest grocery chains to Ottawa to demand that they **take immediate steps** to **reduce and stabilize food prices**. We have also committed to changing the Competition Act to give the bureau more power to hold them accountable.

I'll be in Ottawa over the coming weeks to raise your voice and fight for your concerns, thanks in advance for sharing your ideas with me.
