IMPORTANT CANADA CHILD BENEFIT UPDATE

At the end of May, families who already receive the Canada Child Benefit would have received a retroactive payment for the months of January and April up to an additional \$600 per child under the age of 6. Two more payments of up to \$300 will occur at the end of July and October totalling up to \$1200 in 2021. These additional payments will directly benefit thousands of local families, adding to the increase that families with children of all ages received last year and will help with the additional expenses that having younger kids includes, such as childcare.
